Services we provide



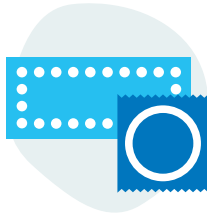
Sexually Transmitted Infections (STIs)

We offer STI screening and treatment. You can also find lots of useful information about the most common STIs on our [digital hub](#).



Pregnancy testing

We offer pregnancy testing across Leeds. We also work with some pharmacies across Leeds who can offer this. Find the nearest pharmacy who can do this on our [digital hub](#).



Contraception

We offer advice, information, fitting and prescriptions for lots of different types of contraception including long and short acting options.

Emergency contraception

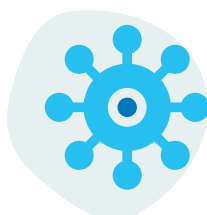
If you need emergency contraception, you can call us.



It's best to act quickly after having unprotected sex (within the first 24 hours). However, there are forms of emergency contraception that can be used for up to five days after.



You can also access emergency contraception from your GP or free of charge from some pharmacies on behalf of Leeds Sexual Health. You can find a list of these pharmacies on the service finder on our [digital hub](#) – please do not wait.



HIV testing, PEP and PrEP (HIV prevention and treatment)

We offer HIV testing, prevention and treatment medication. These are called PEP (Post Exposure Prophylaxis) and PrEP (Pre-Exposure Prophylaxis).



PrEP: If you already receive PrEP from us, you can ask us for a follow-up prescription online if this is better for you. You can request a face to face appointment if this is something you prefer.

PEP: If you think you have been exposed to HIV you may need medicine to reduce your risk of becoming HIV+. This must be started within 72 hours of exposure to be effective. Please call us and tell our care navigators that you think you need PEP. They will ensure you get a call/ appointment as soon as possible.

If it is the evening or weekend or you can't go to your nearest Sexual Health Clinic, please go to your nearest Accident and Emergency (A&E) Department.
